


3. What do you enjoy about being on the team?







2. Why did you want to get involved with ConnectionHub?





Despite the hub being closed due to national COVID restrictions, this week mentors led 17 zoom sessions with students.




At ConnectionHub we believe that education is a powerful tool to help bring people out of such an oppressive environment and give them the confidence to thrive.





Today is World Science Day for Peace and Development!


2. Why did you want to get involved with ConnectionHub?






We are very excited about our new partnership with The University of London that has kindly offered ConnectionHub up to five scholarships for refugees to pursue higher education.

When disasters like the Moria fire strike it is not the time to back down, it is the time to step up, to adapt and to develop.


Following the destruction of the Moria camp, we at ConnectionHub have been reshaping our services to ensure we are doing all we can to meet the needs of the current situation.




"You always have two options: either you turn the page or close the book. I choose to turn the page" ConnectionHub student.






After the news of last nights fire, we have set up a fundraiser to help residents of Moria find safe housing.

Residents of the camp have fled violence and persecution in their home countries to find safe refuge in Greece, only to have that disappear over night.

Thousands have scattered and are being blocked from entering nearby towns due to fears of coronavirus spreading. They have no food and water and nowhere to go.

Each small donation will help us find protective housing for vulnerable people; defending against the spread of coronavirus and allowing them a place to shelter in this isolating time.






Last night a fire devastated Moria refugee camp on Lesbos. Nearly 13,000 vulnerable migrants and refugees are currently without food, water and shelter just days after being collectively quarantined due to a Covid-19 outbreak.





As you will have seen on the news, a fire gutted Moria overnight. A representative from Doctors Without Borders states, 'The whole camp has practically burned to the ground, there is very little standing.'

There are currently thousands of people without shelter having fled the fire. There is limited support available due to the development of coronavirus in the camp last week, and subsequent blockages to accessing Moria.

Please keep the Moria residents in your thoughts. We are hoping for an effective emergency response and that longer term support systems and housing will be available.



Why did you want to get involved with ConnectionHub?



I have loved working with different people, both on the ground and around the UK to fine tune different aspects of the programme to be able to give the best possible opportunities and support to our students.









Secondary Education: Finding a Way Forward for Refugees - ConnectionHub





As you can see below and in the countless articles that have popped up from March onwards, during the last few months of the pandemic we have seen how important it is for students to be able to continue their education. This is something that millions of displaced people face on a daily basis. Accessing education is a serious challenge for refugees and asylum seekers, and a key step in security a fulfilling future in their home or host country. Education means structure, momentum, routine, future thinking, support, self confidence and community, as well as gaining skills and qualifications. This is what we strive to provide at ConnectionHub.

The results reveal that:

- 80% of respondents agreed that the coronavirus pandemic had made their mental health worse. 41% said it had made their mental health "much worse", up from 32% in the previous survey in March. This was often related to increased feelings of anxiety, isolation, a loss of coping mechanisms or a loss of motivation.
- 87% of respondents agreed that they had felt lonely or isolated during the lockdown period, even though 71% had been able to stay in touch with friends.



Among more than 1,000 respondents who were accessing mental health support in the three months leading up the crisis (including from the NHS, school and university counsellors, private providers, charities and helplines), 31% said they were no

I am a history graduate from the University of Exeter. At ConnectionHub I am in the Marketing, Fundraising, and Communications team and am also the Assistant to the


Why did you want to get involved with ConnectionHub?

ConnectionHub provides blended learning opportunities to people in crisis and

conflict contexts. Our aim is to reduce human suffering and exploitation through education and training for decent work and life. Through our student support network, we ensure students have the social support needed for student satisfaction and someone to facilitate their learning journey. We are currently running our pilot project, targeting refugees from Moria camp on the Greek island of Lesbos. In our pilot stage, ConnectionHub aims to provide mental health support to

refugees from Moria Camp, Lesbos. The aim of our Psychological Support Service is to provide a safe, non-judgmental space which is culturally and gender sensitive so that our students can work through past traumatic experiences or current issues to develop positive ways to regain control over their own lives.

Principal Responsibilities:

To provide culturally sensitive counselling support to refugee students undertaking educational pathways at ConnectionHub.

Deliver one to one virtual counselling sessions at regular intervals,




