
EVICTED | HOMELESS | SICK

2022 has been an exceptionally difficult year for refugees and asylum seekers in Europe. In February 2022, the closure of the ESTIA program in Greece was announced, which has, for the last several years, provided people with housing. As a result, thousands of people find themselves evicted and living on the streets or in precarious conditions. In some cases, these forced evictions have led to violence.

We receive dozens of desperate messages from people who find themselves locked out of their apartments, unsure of where to go and how to continue. In many cases, these people and their children have serious medical conditions. We do our best to not lose touch with these people and work with a network of organizations to find (temporary) solutions.



Inter-European Deportation - Sending sick families from Iceland to Athens

Last week, over a dozen asylum-seekers were deported from Iceland to Greece by force. In one case, a man who requires a wheelchair was forcefully removed from his wheelchair and was not provided any alternative!

"The Icelandic Red Cross, Reykjavik Branch has issued a detailed report citing numerous sources that concludes, as has been done many times before, that deporting people to Greece, and children in particular, will send them to a life lived on the street with little to no access to housing, jobs or healthcare"


We can attest to the despair that awaits asylum seekers and recognized refugees who arrive in Athens and hope this practice does not become common place.




Now what?!

The time that people spend on the Aegean islands has decreased substantially. But it doesn't mean they are prepared for Athens. When refugees arrive in the big city, they must figure out transportation, accommodation, access to social services, healthcare...and often, they have to navigate this with little or no Greek language. We regularly see people we met in Lesvos struggling to meet their most basic needs.

#### THE STORIES BEHIND THE NUMBERS

For months, people on the ground in Greece commented that asylum-seeker and refugee numbers on the Aegean islands were trending down. This is true - since 2019, when the migration population of the Aegean islands reached over 40,000 people, the islands have decreased drastically in numbers. However, lower numbers hasn't meant less trauma - it just means the stories have changed. In #Lesvos we see two extremes: those who have arrived to the camp, have their asylum interviews with little or no legal preparation, and take a decision sometimes as soon as ten days upon arrival; and those who languish on Lesvos, sometimes stuck for more than three years, awaiting decisions.

Both experiences bring with them trauma, stress, and concern. For those processed quickly, they often do not have time to adequately prepare. If they receive a positive decision, they suddenly find themselves with no social supports and an order to move off the island. As a result, numbers in mainland Greece have swollen to an unmanageable number. For those who have to wait months and years, they have effectively had to put their lives - and wellbeing - on hold.


Bearing witness to all this means we have seen thousands of vulnerable people in different states of concern.

It doesn't matter whether the number of people in the camp is 20,000 or 2,000, and whether we meet them for three weeks or three years- each person has a story, a concern, a need, and a goal -and each has a right to be cared for.

Unfortunately, we have seen the concerns of thousands of refugees in Greece drop out of mainstream media coverage. Many NGOs have scaled back their services in Lesvos, and in many ways, the gaps that were prevalent at the height of the refugee crisis in Greece persist to this day. In our own small way, we are doing everything we can to adapt to these changes and to continue to provide interpretation, medical logistics, and case management for a growing number of people in need all over

### LANGUAGE JUSTICE

Language and communication are the only instruments we have to convey important messages with each other. For #refugees and #asylumseekers language can be a barrier that results in a life or death situation. When someone goes to the doctor, seeks legal advice, needs psychological intervention, or needs to navigate the bureaucracy of a new country, the ability to communicate is the most important. Improperly conveyed messages have devastating consequences.

In #Greece, refugees face several barriers in accessing services due to linguistic obstacles. Withholding service due to language barriers should never occur. This is #LanguageJustice - a concept that Eudaimonia Medical Services is taking seriously, to ensure that no refugee, asylum-seeker, or vulnerable person faces a system without full comprehension and ability to self-advocate.

This is why we have had a team of 20-35 interpreters since we began - to make sure that everyone can access their most basic of rights, regardless of who they are. So whether our beneficiaries are speaking #Farsi, #Dari, #Pashto, #Arabic, #French, #Portuguese, #Urdu, #Lingala, #Kurdish or even need translation between #Green and #English, we are committed to enshrining their rights and facilitating an easier communication transaction.





As Katie was showing me around the medical area of the Mavrovouni Refugee Camp "Moria 2", two new arrivals were brought into the COVID quarantine area.

Although they had only just reached camp, I knew their boat had landed on Lesvos around six days' ago. It was very likely during that time they'd have had no food or water, hiding scared in the 'jungle'

As is too often the case for those finally reaching Mavrovouni, they were completely exhausted.

Katie's team knew there were two arrivals being registered at camp so were waiting for them. Ready with warm, welcoming smiles and pre-prepared packs including some clothes, shoes, hygiene items, bedding and, of course, water and

Katie and I both had goosebumps. Both grateful that another two vulnerable young people had made it into fortress Europe and, for today at least, were going to be safe.

Katie's vision for Eudiamonia is impressive. She's provided translators at refugee medical appointments, so that people understand what's happening to them, arranged taxi transport to hospital


appointments, paid for medical examinations like MRIs and pet scans and looked after people in quarantine.


She's recently set up a small team making a big difference in Athens too.

Like nearly everyone helping refugees in Greece, Eudaimonia is suffering from a lack of funding and Katie is really sad to be forced to scale back services.

Today they're still providing interpreters and looking after the quarantine area but there's just not enough donations coming in for patient transport or medical examinations and it's devastating to know this puts people's lives at risk.



- ← On the appointment day, we guide the patients through the necessary steps to be allowed out of camp, provide transportation services to and from their appointment location, as well as any logistical arrangements that specific cases may require, and provide interpretation services for them during medical consultations. At the completion of the exams or medical consultations, we proceed with the payment and follow-up with the patients to make sure they receive the results and understand the necessary steps to be taken to access further medical care.



? WHAT DO WE DO ?

- It's been a couple of months that Eudaimonia Medical Services is in charge, alongside Greek authorities, of the isolation area of the RIC Mavrovouni Camp.
- ♦ Our team is available 24/7 to welcome any new arrivals. We keep track of the number of people who are living in the isolation area. With the help of Eurorelief, Eudaimonia provides them with Non-Food Items upon arrival (i.e. blankets, sleeping bag, bedsheets, etc.). Our team carries out distribution of the food that is provided by the State. The medical care is handled by the Public Health Authorities. Now that there are WASH facilities we hope to be a part of making this area as comfortable as

Unfortunately, their asylum request has been rejected twice, which means that they have lost their right to medical insurance in Greece. This is how they ended up being registered in our complex cases program

eo Eudaimonia arranged a meeting with the ophthalmologist for their sight to be re-assessed and get a prescription for new glasses. They were accompanied all the way by S., one of our translators. Both F. and T. were provided with the two pairs they needed, one to see from a distance and one to see closer.

// 11 YEARS OF WAR IN SYRIA //

 $\pmb{\times}$  Today we acknowledge the devastating anniversary of the Syrian war.

As many of our team members are Syrian, this conflict is always on our minds. Eudaimonia Medical Services thinks of all the people who were and are still affected by this terrible conflict.

Before the war, the Syrian population was of 22 million people. Since then, more than half of the population was forced to flee their home. As of June 2021, the UNHCR counts 6,7 million internally displaced persons in Syria, and as of March 2022, the UN agency counts 5,7 million Syrian refugees. Most of them have fled to Turkey, Lebanon, Jordan, Iraq and Egypt.

The war in Syria is not over and 11 years after it began, it has cost over half a million lives, whether it be militaries or civilians.

The economy of the country has collapsed and the UN estimates that 8 million of Syrian suffer from food defficiency, which represents more than half of the current population.

▲ Let us not forget that this protracted conflict still forces people out of their home, costs innocent lives and destroys the country.




# 11 years of war in Syria

places continue to risk their lives daily working with positive COVID patients and only basic PPE. Receiving this request from Eudaimonia was a stark reminder.

Katie, co-founder of Eudaimonia says -

"The second wave of Covid in the camp has caused a rapid and near-fatal situation. But we are learning that when people have the information they need, they are more calm. Many people feel that we are on the cusp of a serious incident in the camp, and our information campaign, plus following up with close contacts and spreading awareness messaging, will play a major role.

"As a one-off project we have been asked to provide additional support in terms of health promotion including:

- translating WHO texts,
- providing information about vaccines,
- providing NFIs (non food items) to isolation area,

and more. We have a team who has trained for this, but it will require long hours and extra measures to ensure the safety of those in camp, as well as our team.



### A HERO'S JOURNEY -

Nesar is a one in a billion type of person. Sincere, kind-hearted, selfless and dedicated, we were incredibly lucky to meet him nearly one year ago in Moria Camp. His journey as a refugee started years ago due to his involvement as a translator for the UK and US soldiers in Afghanistan. He and his wife survived against all odds and arrived in Lesvos on December 31, 2019 - minutes before midnight. Their next few months were spent under tremendous hardship enduring the most difficult parts of Moria. In May 2020 he joined our team of translators and quickly became one of our most invaluable volunteers. Always willing to come to shift early or stay late, assisting anyone who needed translation, he seemed to put everyone else's needs before his own.

When the first case of Covid was discovered in Moria, he volunteered to translate in the isolation area and spent his days sweating in a full hazmat suit under a scorching 30-degree sun.

On the night of the fire on September 8, 2020, Nesar was one of the first people in camp to notice something was not right. He immediately informed our management team who then were able to notify authorities. Through this action alone, Nesar may have saved countless lives - ensuring many people fled before fire reached their tent.

Marar stained anishes for 40 hours aroulding amorganse translations to inhance

required them in the days after the fire. Throughout all of this, he was dedicated to making it to his final destination: UK. He wanted to meet the soldiers with whom he'd worked in Afghanistan. And after unending diplomatic efforts from both Greece and the UK, Nesar's wish came true.

Two weeks ago, Nesar and his wife landed in Britain - finding both freedom and a promise of a better life.

His absence on the ground has been felt and his contributions to our team were immeasurable. We know we will meet him again (he's already invited our whole team for tea) and we are so happy that someone who spent so long working so selflessly has finally reached his goal. We will never be able to properly convey our gratitude to you, Nesar. But we know that we were a better organization because of you.




Did you know that in countries like Afghanistan, whose education system has been devastated by decades of war, 60% of out-of-school children are girls?

In a typical day in the medical clinic inside RIC Lesvos, our translators work closely with other medical actors in different areas - crowd control, reception area, consultations and triage tables - in order to facilitate refugees' access to medical care.

"One of the most difficult parts of translating at triage is that you never know what you are going to get. Patients may start complaining of a headache, but after a few minutes you have a hard story of their lives. Maybe they've been abused or had to

flee wars. Maybe they haven't had access to medical care in months or years. What we discuss at triage table might be the first time a patient has the chance to tell their story" tells Noori - Farsi translator in RIC Mayrovouni camp.







Trainings and resources are offered to the team to ensure their knowledge of medical terms is up to date. 


Today we want to introduce you to one of our biggest programmes.

In our Complex Cases program we receive medical referrals from medical actors and organizations for MRIs, CTs, X-rays, Ultrasounds and Bloodworks that cannot be done through the public health system.

Once the exams are done, our team delivers the results to the patients in person and follows up with them to help them understand what they have to do to receive adequate medical care.





You may recognize Maryam from the incredible photos of Yousif Alshewaili.

We received a special pediatric wheelchair from a German couple with one request: the wheelchair had a sentimental meaning for them and they wanted to make sure it got to a child who was really in need of it.

Yesterday we met Maryam's family at the medical centre in RIC Lesvos and our translator learned that Maryam's previous wheelchair had been stolen.

For those who don't know her story, Maryam is just six years old and after facing more trauma than any person should experience in an entire lifetime, her psychological and physical health has been compromised. Not only has she stopped talking - she has also stopped being able to walk. Her last wheelchair was an adult wheelchair which didn't fit her properly.

Today we met her and her father to give them a special pediatric wheelchair that is suited to her needs.
