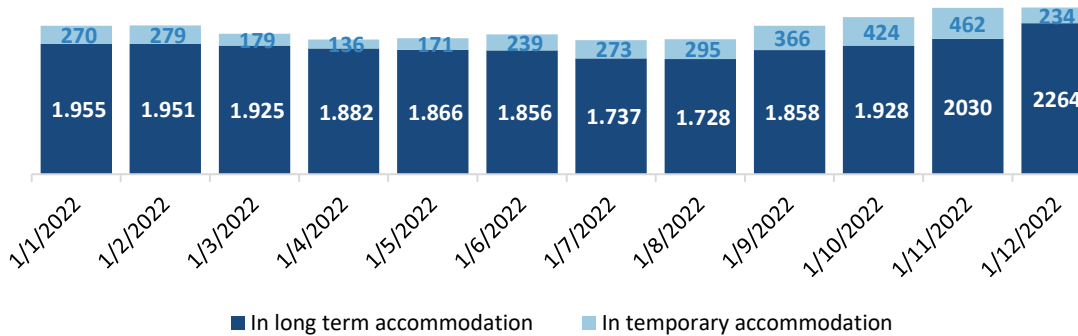

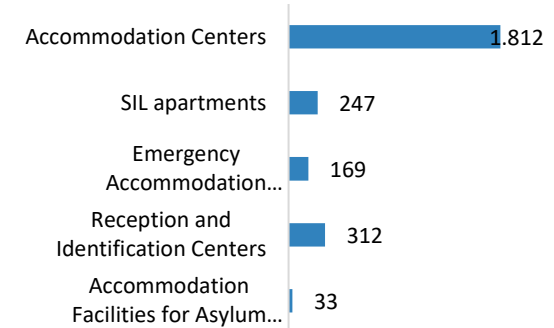

01 January 2021 - 01 December 2022

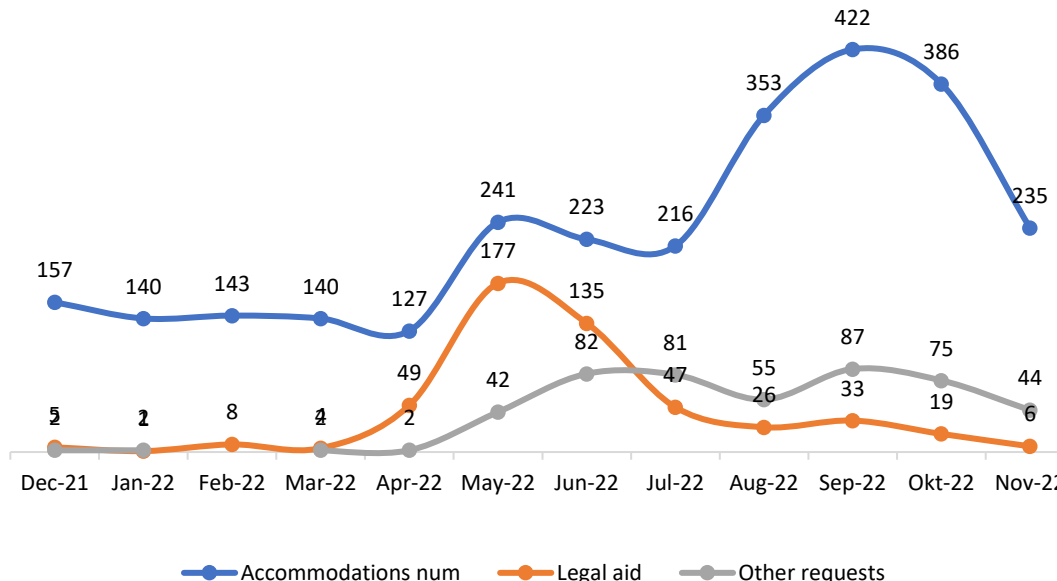


**UAC analysis per accommodation type**

## National Emergency Response Mechanism



*The National Emergency Response Mechanism for Unaccompanied Minors (UAC) in precarious living conditions launched the telephone line in April 2021. Until today, the Mechanism received **7,856** calls, which concern **5,785** different cases of (UACs), out of which **4,752** concern accommodation requests, **525** legal aid, and **507** other requests.*

*Since 02.03.2022, the line has received referrals for **3** unaccompanied\* and **514** separated minors from Ukraine.*

*\*there are cases of unaccompanied minors whose status changes from unaccompanied to separated following their initial referral.*

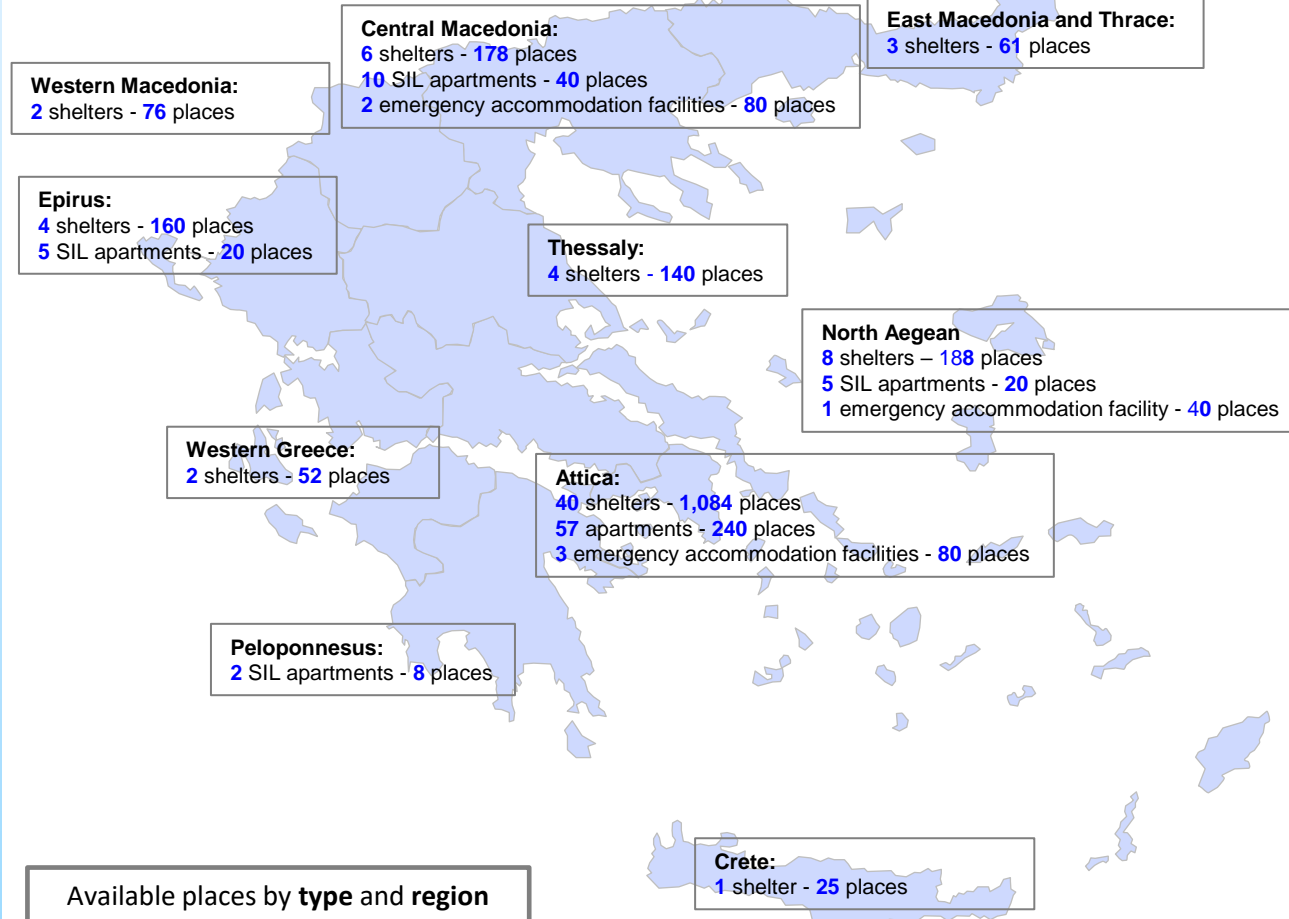
- **Current: 70** UAC shelters with total **1,960** places

- **Current: 79** SIL apartments for UAC older than 16 years old with total **328** places

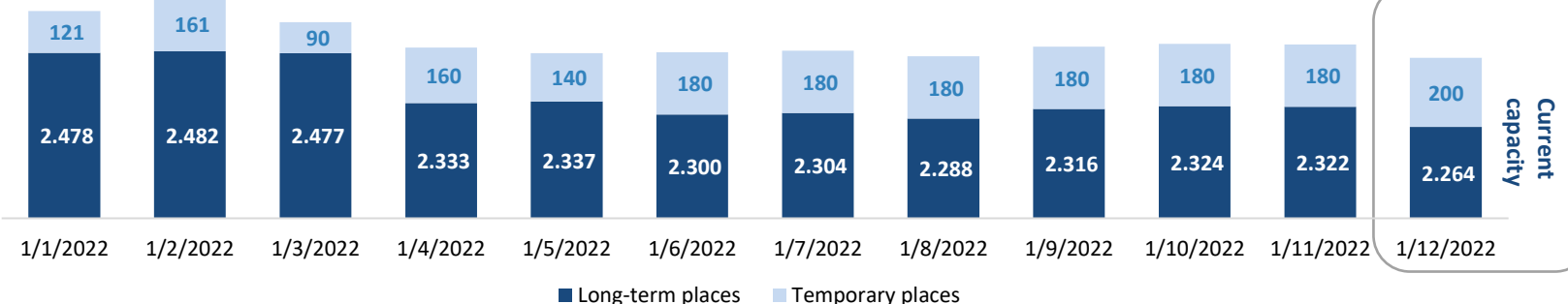
## Emergency accommodation facilities

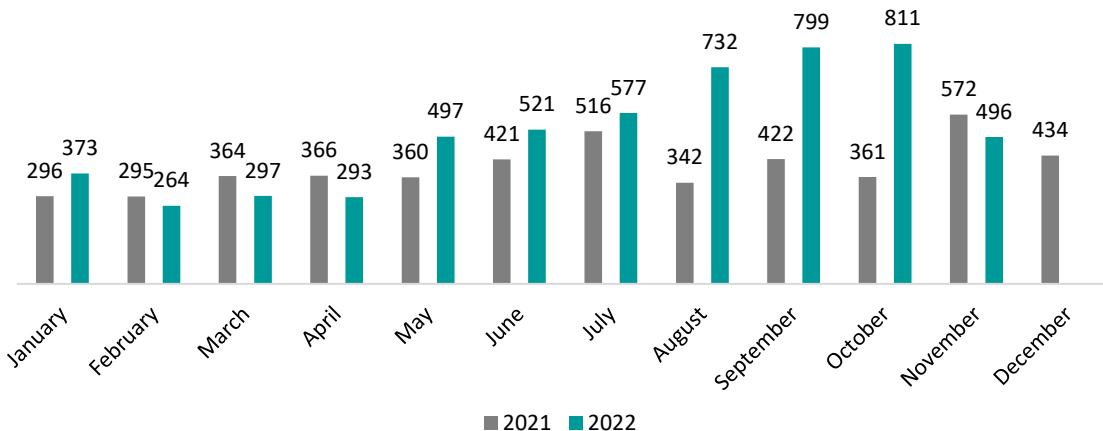

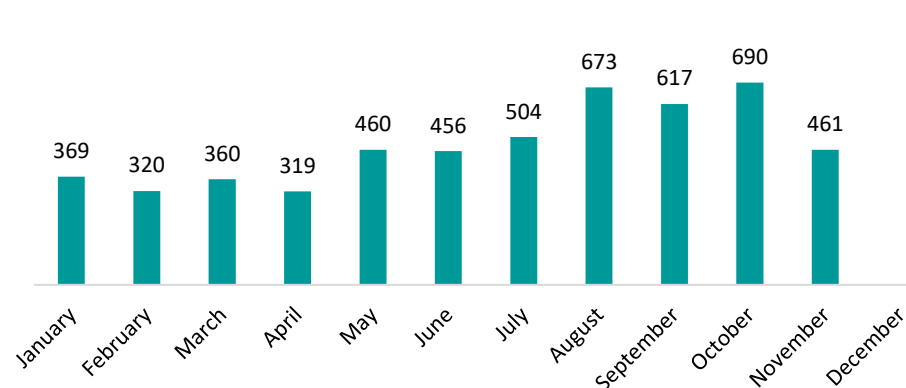

Referrals processed\* per month

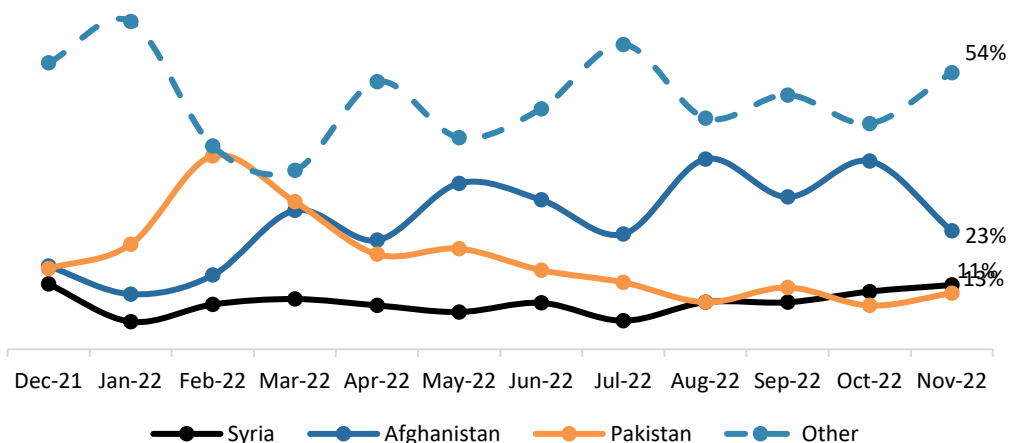
