



Emergency The National Response Mechanism for Unaccompanied Minors (UAC) in precarious living conditions launched the telephone line in April 2021 assumed the accommodation of unaccompanied minors in June of the same year. Until the end of February 2022, the Mechanism received 3,526 calls, which concern **2,180** different cases of (UAC), out of which 2,078 concern accommodation requests, 89 legal aid, and 12 other requests. As of 02.03.2022, the line has received 45 calls for separated minors from Ukraine.






