Summary of the Case: On Monday the 24th of December at 6:16am CET the Alarm phone shift team was sent a phone number and GPS coordinates of a group of 14 travellers (including 8 women and 1 child) who were stranded on the small island of Oinousses, a small island close to Chios. Unable to make contact with the group, we alerted the Chios port authority who later, at 8:20am, informed us that they had found the group on rocks near to the sea and were bringing them to the camp in Chios. We received confirmation of this at 2:23pm from our contact person.
